Milestones to keep in mind:

by 9 months - sitting independently

by 15 months - walking

under 3

Children under 3 years of age who have a significant delay in development or a condition known to have a high probability resulting in significant delays in development are eligible for San Juan Kids' services.

under 5

how to receive services

1. call us
2. receive a free home visit
3. get a brief screening or a full evaluation to determine eligibility
4. if eligible, together we will create an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP)
